

The Northbrook Police Department (North Suburban Chicago) is recruiting public safety dispatchers who will receive 911 system emergency and non-emergency calls, dispatch Police response, monitor status of response and maintain related records.? Duties also include operating LEADS, NCIC, and Village computer networks to retrieve law enforcement related information as needed by officers.

Candidates must be at least 21 years old and possess, or be able to obtain within the first year of employment, a current Law Enforcement Agency Data System (LEADS) certification. ? High school diploma or GED required and one to three years related communications or Police Department experience preferred.? Must be skilled in typing, exercise good judgment, and be able to handle confidential material in a professional manner.

After completing a six month training period with rotating shifts, the position is a permanent midnight shift.
